

ITEMS TO BRING

- **A smartphone**, ideally with a good camera.
Phones that can shoot “Log” (iPhone 15 onwards) and have Lidar sensors are extra useful, but not required. You will be creating some content direct from your phone, as well as sharing content via apps.
More recent phones tend to have exceptional cameras, you can look for refurbished phones and you certainly don’t need the very latest model.
- **A 1TB external hard drive.**
You will be creating video content, and these files can get large. This will be useful for keeping a backup of your work and transferring files between different workstations and making sure you don’t lose your projects! A Solid-State Drive is ideal.
- **An SD Card, 128GB +.**
It’s useful to have your own SD card for shooting footage on.
- **A water bottle**
(Hydration is key to a good day! Art is exercise.)
- Blank lined notebook.
- Blank sketchbook.
- Pens & pencils. (These are useful for taking notes in lectures, sketching out ideas, content plans, story boards etc. These items are also available from the campus shop)

NON-ESSENTIAL

You are welcome to bring:

- Your own personal computer.
- Your own camera, microphone, tripod etc.
- SD card reader, adapters, and dongles.

Don’t worry if you can’t purchase equipment, we have a range of cameras, microphones, lights, accessories, tripods, gimbals that you can borrow for your projects.

There are some benefits to having your own camera, which you can get to know inside out. Look for a mirrorless camera that is made for shooting video. Look out for student discounts and offers.

The College will give you access to high powered computers, the Adobe Creative Suite and other essential software from within the campus computers. You will also have space on One Drive for storing your files in the cloud.
