You will need to come prepared with a few essential tools and bits of equipment to get you started in the workshops. There are a lot of tools and equipment available to you, however it may be useful to start a small toolkit of your own. These are available to purchase from a variety of places such as B&Q, ToolStation, Screwfix etc... You can then gradually populate this according to need as you progress through the course.

In the meantime, there are a few things you need to buy initially that will prove to be useful.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

- Overalls/warehouse coat - cotton/polyester. These are used to protect your clothes when using the workshops.

Drawing and Designing Materials:

- A range of drawing materials, which could include pencils/gouache/pastels/charcoal*
- Erasers*
- Sketch book (A3 minimum) *
- Hard back note pad (A5) *
- Steel ruler*
- Compass/Protractor
- Cutting mat* & quality craft knife
- Large capacity memory stick
