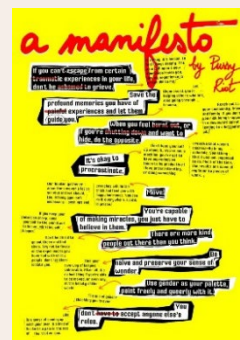


UAL Level 3 Foundation Diploma in Art & Design

Matchbox Manifesto

We would like for you to create your own manifesto (a statement of beliefs and aims) of your intentions for your Foundation year and present it within a matchbox at the 'Meet the Tutors' Day in early September.

Consider how the manifesto and the matchbox (container) can work together to communicate your 'declaration of intentions'. Think broadly about what you could do to exploit the physical nature of the matchbox – consider surface, extensions, additions, textures, found text / objects, even multiples.



Task

1. Create a list of things that you want to achieve during your Foundation Year.
2. Use your list as a catalyst for creating your manifesto. Remember the manifesto can be a combination of text / image / object / etc.
3. Develop possibilities of presenting your manifesto within a matchbox, think about composition, scale, format, aesthetics and how your audience will view the work. Be brave and be honest to yourself!
4. Finalise the work in preparation for 'Meet the Tutors' day to share with your peers and tutors.
5. Your work will be displayed in college within a collective exhibition at the start of term.

Bring your holiday work in on 'Meet Your Tutor' day. It is not needed on enrolment day. Make sure that all of your collections are labelled with your name.

Be brave, be curious and creative and approach this project with an open mind, you will not be judged on what you select, this is personal to you.
